JUNE MEETING MINUTES

The June 30, 2018 meeting was held at Killeen Field. Mike Stone opened the meeting at 9:55am. The May 26, 2018 Meeting Minutes were approved as written. Bill Rothenbuhler gave the Treasurer's Report, stating how much we have in our Checking Account.

Bob Estrella gave the Membership Report, stating that we have 47 members in the Club, noting that only 17 members have renewed so far.

Old Business:

Mike Stone reviewed where we are regarding our status at Killeen Field as follows:

- In a Telecon from Chris Kiralla four weeks ago, he said he's increasing our rent to \$1000/month and is sending us a Letter stating same.
- In a follow up Telecon a week later, Chris did not accept our offer to pay \$500/month providing he gives us at least a 1 year Lease.
- We have not received the "Rent Increase Letter".
- Chris has not returned any of our calls. (Left 4 messages 2 weeks ago).

- Letter mailed to Chris Kiralla on June 26th with \$330 Check for July Rent, stating the following:
 - We can't afford to pay any more than the current \$330/month rent.
 - Get back with us telling us whether or not you will accept that.
 - If you don't agree to that, we will vacate effective August 1st.
 - If we don't hear from you by Friday, July 6th, we will vacate effective August 1st.

NOTE: At this writing, July 8, 2018, we have not heard back from Chris Kiralla, nor have we received the "Rent Increase Letter".

Mike Stone stated that we have power now in all areas, Mansion, Kitchen Area, East Pits and West Pits. **Thank you Skip & Bob Shaw!** Mike Stone noted that we will be holding our Summer Night Fly on

Saturday, July 7th. Bob Estrella urged members to attend, as it is an enjoyable evening out.

Mike Stone listed remaining 2018 Events, stating "If we are still here".

New Business:

Bob Estrella read an email that he received from the Hemet Model Masters stating that they are "very sorry to hear" about our Field situation. The Letter went on to describe their membership costs. Harry Hill, President of the AMAA (Fisherman's Retreat) Club introduced himself. He stated that our members are welcome to come and fly at their Fisherman's Retreat Flying Field in Redlands if we lose our Field.

Mike Stone stated that he has also received the same offer from the M.A.R.K.S Club. Bob Jones stated that the same offer would be made by the Riverside RC Club.

Bob Estrella showed his FMS 70mm EDF F/A-18F. He noted that the "scale like" Landing Gear is very impressive. He demonstrated the retractable Mains & Nose Gear after the meeting.
